ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Attorneys Representing Criminal Clients in Custody

Attorneys will report to the Court Clerk's Office to announce their appearance Client is in attendance. These cases will be conducted with Defendant and/or their attorney present in the Courtroom along with the Judge and Court staff. A member of the Attorney General's Office will be present at these hearings. All those present will maintain social distancing. Witnesses will remain outside of the Courtroom until called into the Courtroom by a member of the Court staff.

Private Counsel and their Clients

Private Counsel and only their Clients will report to the waiting area of the Courthouse. All individuals must maintain appropriate social distance. All attorneys and clients will remain outside the courtroom in the waiting area established by the Court Administrator or the Judge or Justices. The cases will be called individually and the parties will enter Courtroom and only with escort from a Court staff member. The Judge and Court staff will be in Courtroom. A member of the Attorney General's Office will be present at these hearings. Attorneys and clients are encouraged to exit the Courthouse once their matter is concluded.

Pro Se Litigants

Pro Se litigants will be instructed to report to the waiting area and sign in with persons located within the waiting area of the Courthouse. Clients will be allowed to stay in the waiting area only if their names and case number are listed on the docket. Their cases will be called individually. A member of the Attorney General's Office will be present at these hearings.

Filings with the Court Clerk's Office

All persons wanting to file documents with the Court Clerk's Office may do so electronically or in person

All Persons Entering the Courthouse

All persons entering the Courthouse are strongly encouraged to wear a cloth covering or mask over their mouth and nose. They are also strongly encouraged to use the hand sanitizer liberally and wash their hands regularly with soap and water.
