PROMISE TO APPEAR-AGREEMENT TO RELEASE

The undersigned being the parent, guardian, or person having the custody of _____ a minor, do hereby make request and enter into this agreement to secure the release of said named Juvenile to my custody upon my binding declaration and this written agreement to bring said minor Juvenile before the Court as I may now or hereinafter be directed.

This agreement is entered into pursuant to the provisions of Title 9, Wyandotte Nation Juvenile Procedure Code pertaining to delinquent juveniles taken into custody upon charges of violating the laws of the Wyandotte Nation.

I hereby declare and understand that upon failure to produce said named Juvenile to Wyandotte Nation Juvenile Services for an intake conference or subsequent proceedings upon said charges pending for the violation of said Tribal Codes, may render me to be held in contempt of Court, bench warrant issued, and if convicted of such offense, the Court may impose a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and may commit him to the custody of the Nation's Police for a term of sixty (60) days. Further, that such fine or criminal prosecution for violation of this agreement shall in no way interfere with or prevent the exercise by the Court of its powers of contempt for willful violation.

Therefore, in consideration of the release of said Juvenile to me, I do hereby agree to CALL WYANDOTTE NATION JUVENILE SERVICES at 918-678-6376 by close of business on the next working business day to schedule an appointment for an intake conference.

The release of this Juvenile is authorized under this agreement by the District Judge of the Wyandotte Nation Tribal Court and pursuant to said codes of the Wyandotte Nation. I further understand it is my duty to keep Wyandotte Nation Juvenile Service advised of any change of address.
