**CHAPTER ONE  
JURISDICTION AND APPLICABLE LAW**

**Section 101. Short Title and Citation.**

This Title may be cited as the Wyandotte Nation Probate Code.

**Section 102. Jurisdiction.**

The Courts of the Wyandotte Nation shall have jurisdiction to administer in probate the estate of a deceased Indian who, at the time or his or her death, was domiciled or owned real or personal property situated within the Reservation of the Wyandotte Nation under the jurisdiction of the Wyandotte Courts to the extent that such estate consists of property which does not come within the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior if the Court finds that a State court will not take jurisdiction over such an estate.

**Section 103. Applicable Law.**

The Courts of the Wyandotte Nation shall adopt and use the provisions of 25 CFR Part 11, Subpart G, and relevant parts of Oklahoma Statutes as may be mandated to be used by applicable Federal statutes, as the law and procedure to be used in such cases.
