The email address provided on page 2 should be one that you check often. This will be the primary method used for communication because it helps us keep a record of all communication between the applicant and the Housing Department.

If you reside in the dorms, a copy of your current account summary showing dorm/residence fees must be provided for **EACH** semester of the school year. Assistance for the next semester will not be paid until the current account summary has been provided.

If you will be renting a unit, a copy of your current lease must be submitted with your application. If the lease dates do not cover the entire school year, a new updated lease will need to be provided before further assistance is paid once the lease terms are up. Also, your **Landlord** must furnish a completed W-9 to the Housing Department in order to process a check for your assistance. An applicant's parent (parent, step-parent, in-laws) will not be paid assistance as a landlord, regardless of whether there is a lease involved. This is considered a conflict of interest. By initialing here, you agree that your Landlord is not a parent of you, the applicant.

To continue receiving assistance, you understand that all semester grades and schedules must be turned in to the Education Department. The Education Department must clear you for funding **EACH** semester before the Housing Department will pay assistance.

If completed application and backup documentation are not turned in within a timely manner, you understand that we will not guarantee funding. There are a limited number of students we can offer assistance to, and assistance will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis. Also, if paperwork is turned in after assistance has already begun, you understand that assistance will not be paid retroactively and any missed month's funding will be forfeited.

**The Housing Department will contact you should anything be missing, however, it is your responsibility to make sure that all required documentation (application and backup) is turned into our office in a timely manner.**

**I verify that all information submitted is true to the best of my knowledge. I understand that should I decide not to attend college or if my housing situation changes, I will notify the Housing Office immediately. Failure to do so will require all funding to be returned.**
